SCOPE

Tinkering for sustainability at school is an ERASMUS+ KA2 two-years long project launched in the end of 2022, seeking to propose "tinkering" as an approach to be merged with Education for Sustainable Development (ESD). To this end, methodology & educational activities (toolkit) around sustainability and climate topics will be developed for late primary and early secondary level students (9-12 years).

DEVELOPING THE TINK@SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

The second half of 2023 was very creative for the Partners since they developed their tinkering activities. The Partners were mentored by NEMO that peer-reviewed the advanced drafts. The produced 10 activities will be included in the Tink@School Toolkit accompanied by a Facilitation Guide to further support educators during implementation. The activities actually fall in the following three categories: (a) **Tinkering solutions**: activities can lead to solving problems related to sustainability challenges, through inventing creative ways and even, as a result of an accidental discovery! (b) **Re-use & Re-duce**: activities that make use of recycled materials or activities inviting students to come up with their new ways to reuse/repair waste (c) **Tinkering for change**: activities that motivate in a fun and creative way to changes in others, conveying a message about sustainability or climate change.

Following the drafting of the tinkering activities the partners pilot tested them with school students and teachers of their areas during Sept 2023-Jan 2024. The schools engaged in the pilots were: Helgafellsskóli (Island), Ilaria Alpi School (Milan), Anna Micheli & Pablo Neruda (Rome), 1st Highschool & 70th Primary (Athens), 6th Primary (Chalandri) and teachers from Amsterdam.
